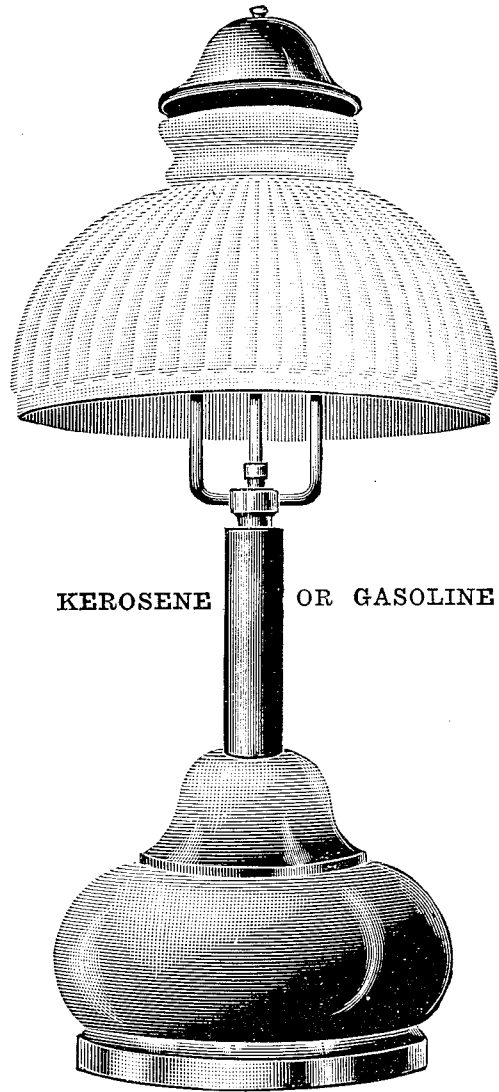

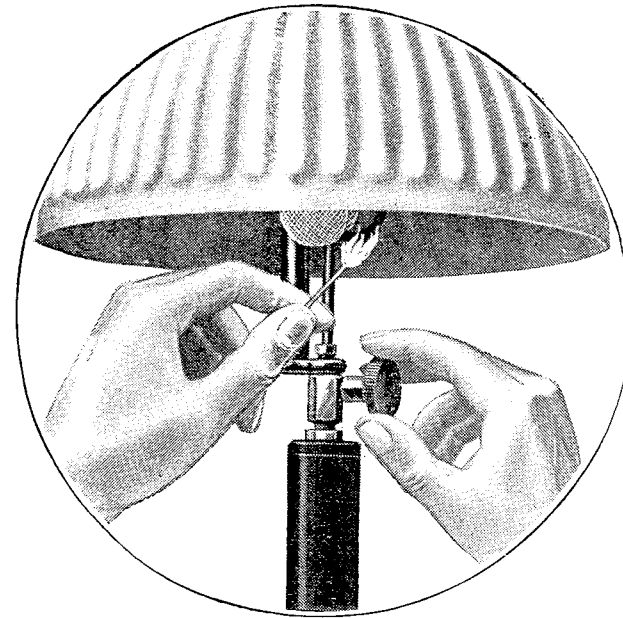

The illustration shows the patented match-lighting coil which makes the Quick-Lite different from, and superior to all other lamps and lanterns.

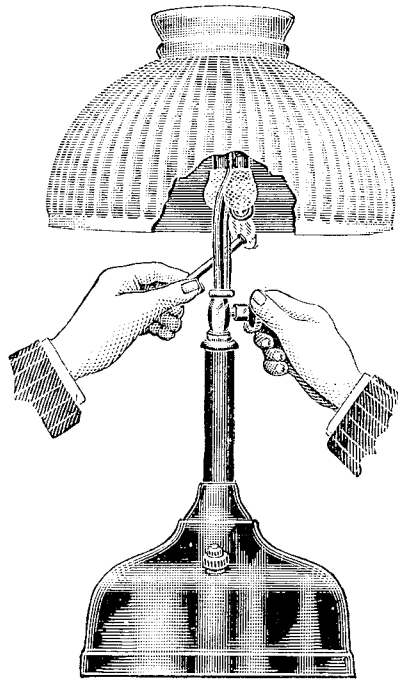
The Quick-Lite burner lights with a common match, no other generating required.

The Quick-Lite is a miniature gas plant. It makes its own gas from common gasoline.

The fuel is poured in the fount, the filler cap replaced and a few strokes of air pumped in with the simple pump furnished with every lamp.

The gasoline feeds up the standard and is controlled by the valve shown in the cut. When it reaches the coil between the mantles it is burned into vapor. This vapor mixes with air entering thru the larger tube, forming a gas that burns like any gas.

Unlike other gasoline lamps, the Quick-Lite requires no alcohol or torch to generate. Simply use a common match.

The Quick-Lite burns gasoline safer than any oil lamp made burns kerosene. Explosion is impossible. No danger if lamp is dropped or overturned. It greatly lessens danger of fire.

The Quick-Lite produces five times the light of a big center draft oil lamp, at one-third the cost and is practically indestructible. It soon saves its price in cost of operation.

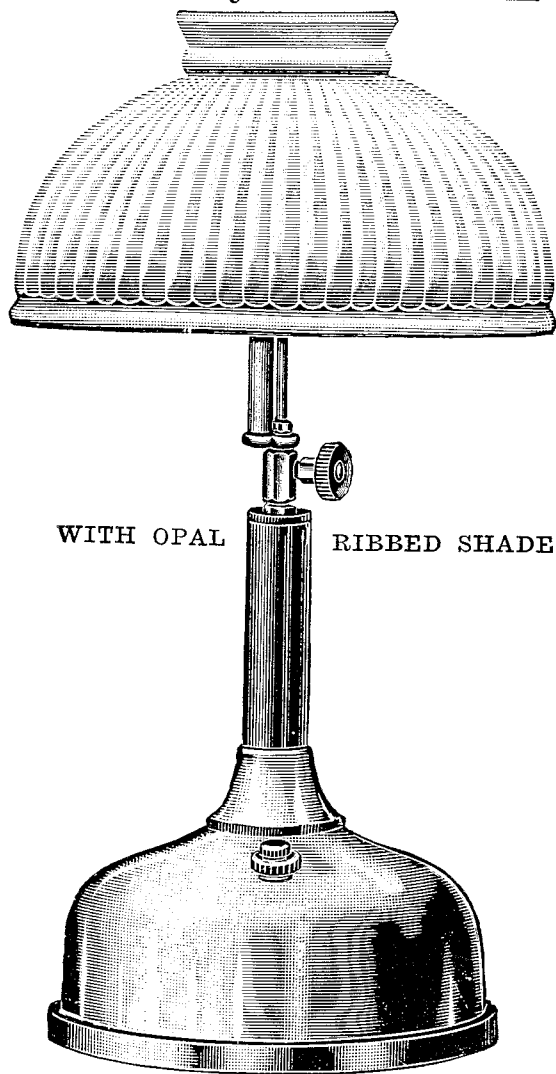

THE QUICK-LITE HAS MADE GOOD

Every year it makes a hundred thousand new friends who would not think of going back to the kerosene lamp or the old style torch generating gasoline burners.

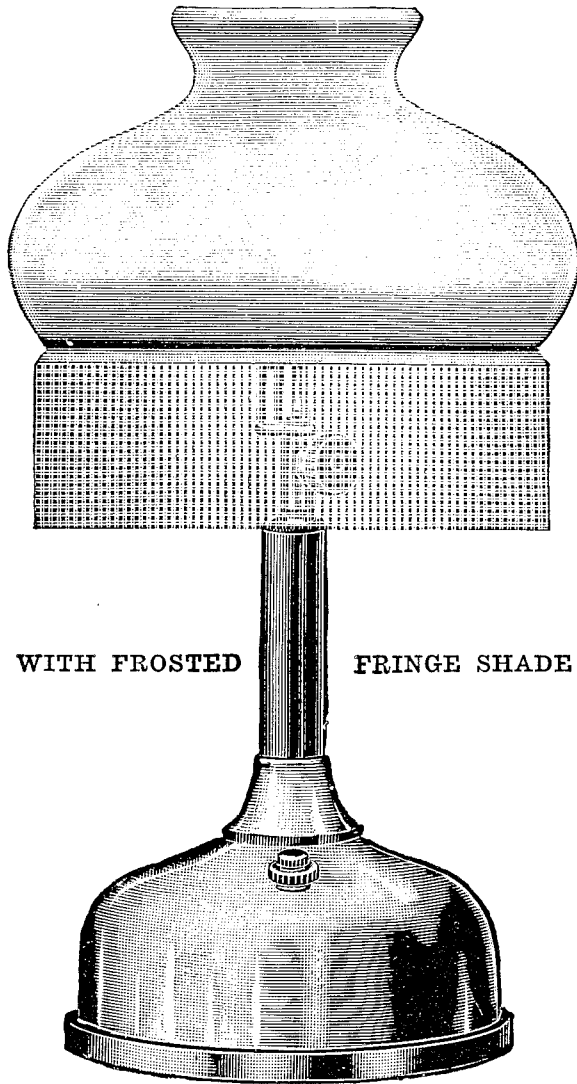
The convenience of the match lighting burner quickly appeals to any one having experience with other gasoline lamps that require a torch and alcohol to light them.

The simple, inexpensive generator, which never requires cleaning, used on the Quick-Lite is an advantage of no less merit than the match lighting feature. Instead of having to clean the generator by digging out the old charred filter, as is necessary in torch lighting lamps, you simply unscrew one nut, slip out the old generator and put in the new one. When this is done you have practically a new lamp.

All Quick-Lite Lamps are made of brass heavily nickeled and will give many years of satisfactory service. Unfortunately some people do not appreciate the difference between lamps made of brass and the many imitations of this metal now being placed on the market. To save a few cents many manufacturers are using steel founts and iron burner castings when brass is the only metal that will prove satisfactory. Steel founts rust out and iron parts in the burner warp and become loose, causing a leakage of gas and a disagreeable odor in the room.

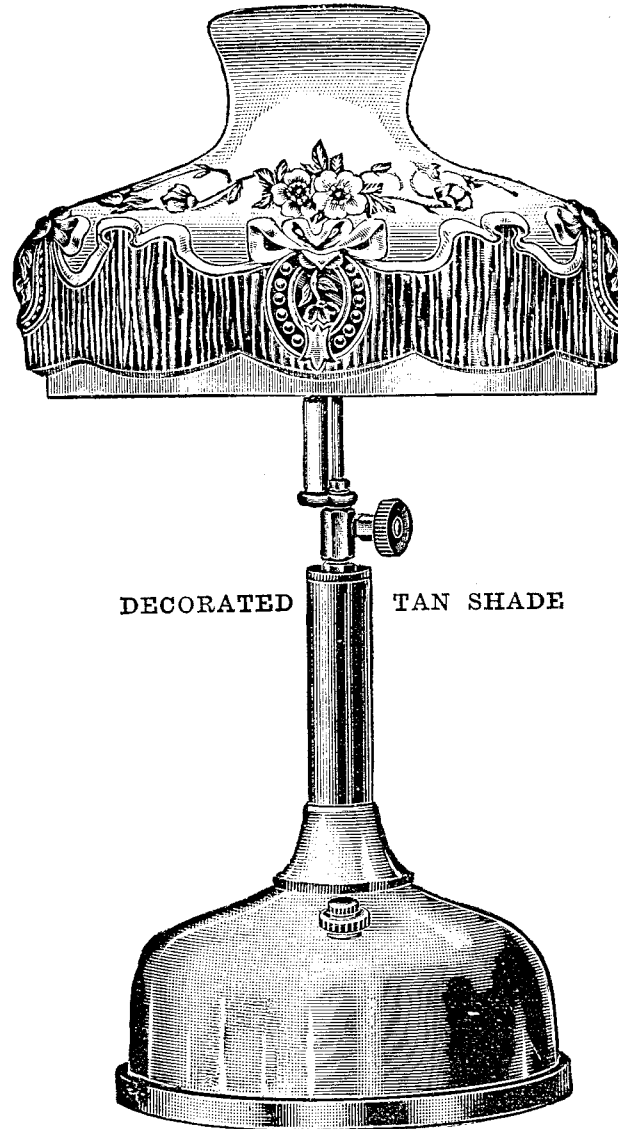


WITH FROSTED FRINGE SHADE

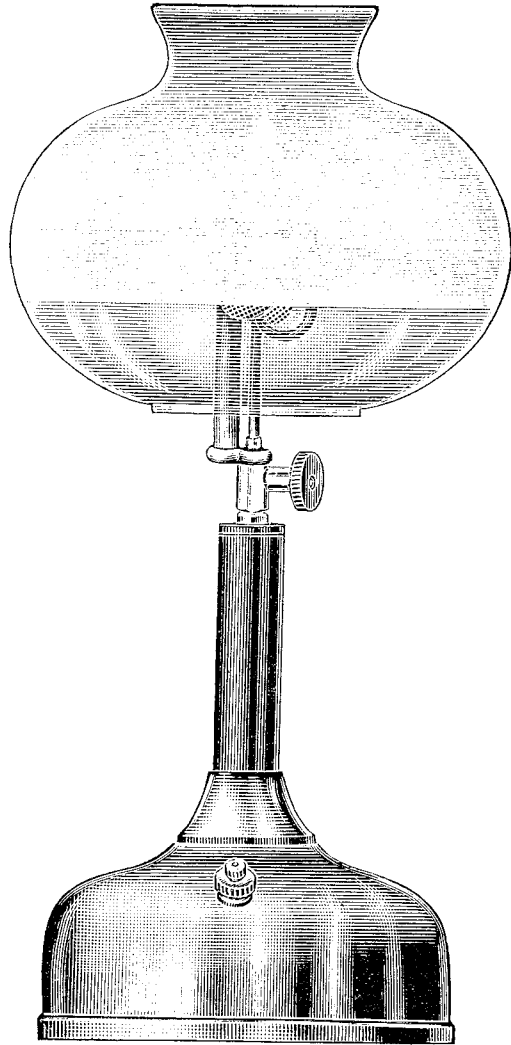


DECORATED TAN SHADE

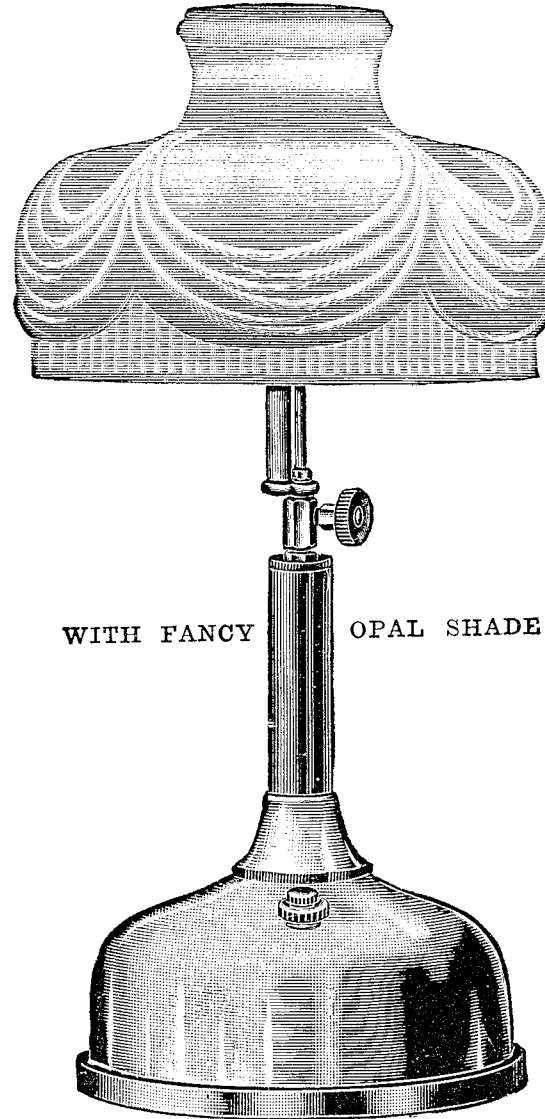

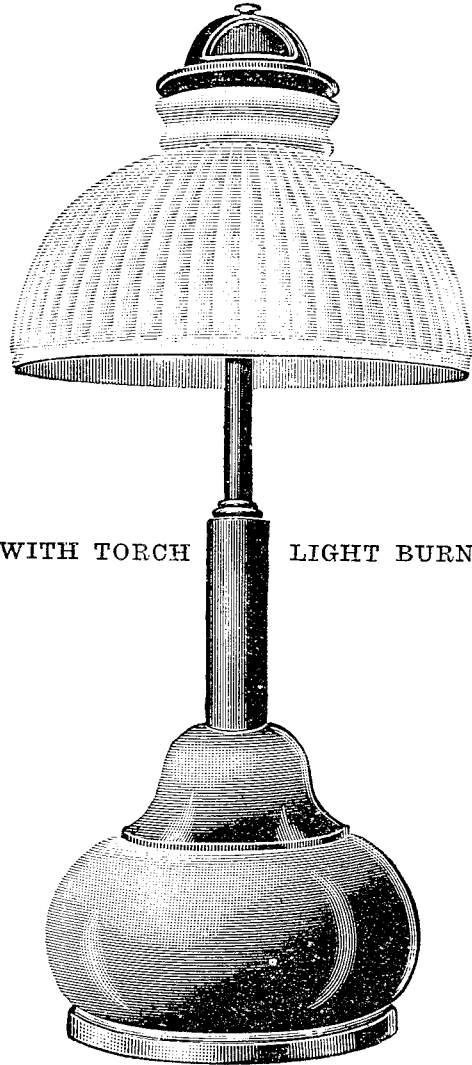


WITH FANCY OPAL SHADE

THE AIR-O-LITE

WITH QUICK-LITE BURNER

For many years No. A 307 Air-O-Lite has been the most popular gasoline lamp on the market. More of them have probably been sold than all other styles put together.

Because of the popularity of the fount of this lamp we are also equipping it with the Quick-Lite burner, designating it as the model AQ. If wanted with the torch generator, order model A with style of shade desired; thus A 307, the ribbed shade; A 314-A the hand painted, green shade with windmill scene, etc. The heat bell is not used on model AQ lamps. The price of model A and AQ lamps is the same.

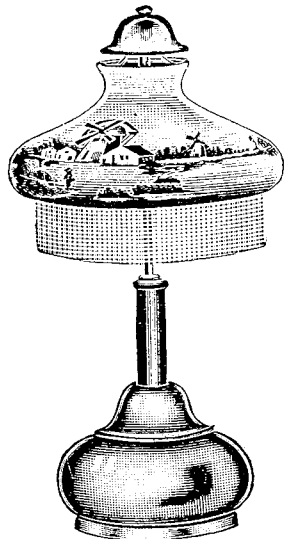
These lamps are made of brass heavily nicked and are good for a lifetime of service. Thousands of them have been in daily use for the past six or seven years and are apparently as good as ever.

There is still some demand for the torch lighting lamp, but the Quick-Lite burner, because of its convenience of lighting, will eventually replace it.

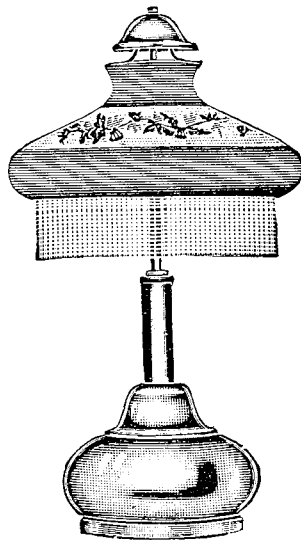
Many regard it as the most handsome shade in the entire line.

It is in no sense gaudy and when lighted the effect is a mellow light, very pleasing and restful to the eye.

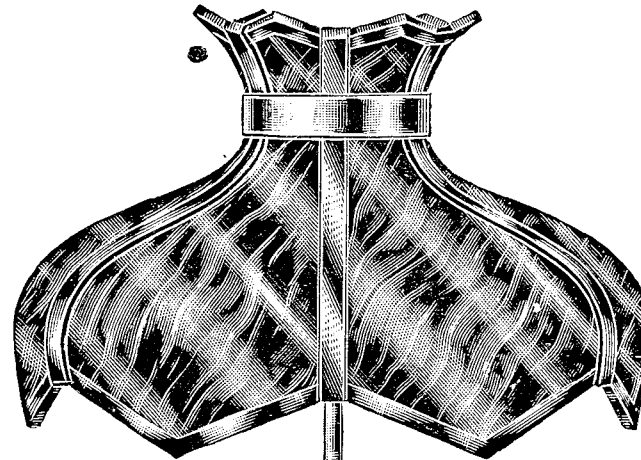
The Air-O-Lite burner is practically indestructable. Pure nickel, which never burns out, is used in burner cap screens.



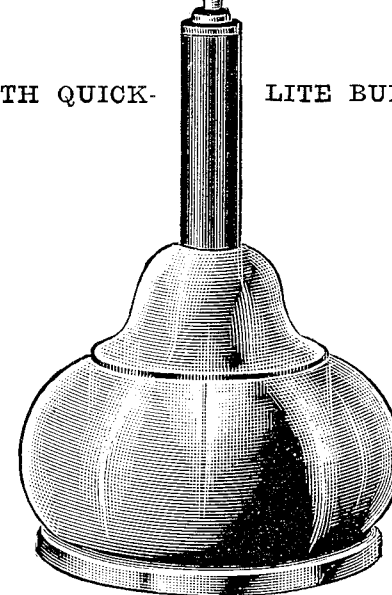

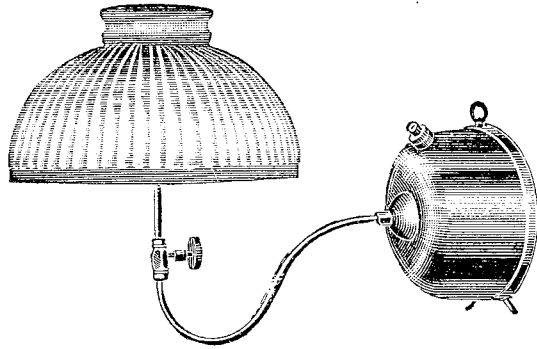
WITH QUICK-LITE BURNER

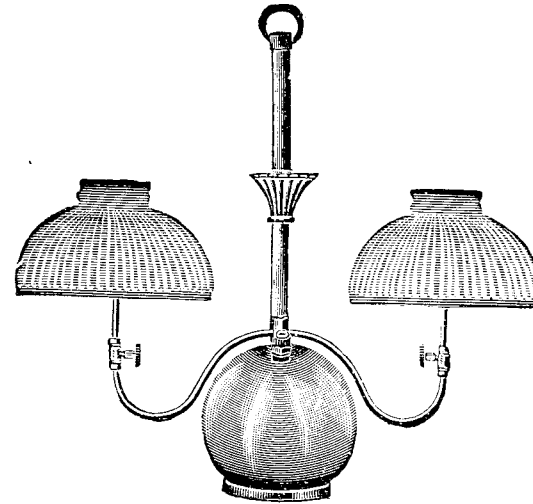
THE QUICK-LITE CHANDELIERS

It is supplied by a single seamless fount which holds six pints and is made of 18 gauge brass. On each arm is a Quick-Lite burner with universal shade holder. Either one or both may be lighted as desired.

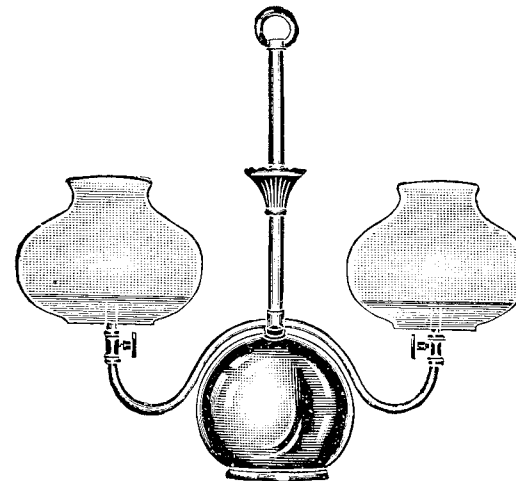
This fixture makes a great emergency light. can be carried from place to place and used between the country church, school house and residence.

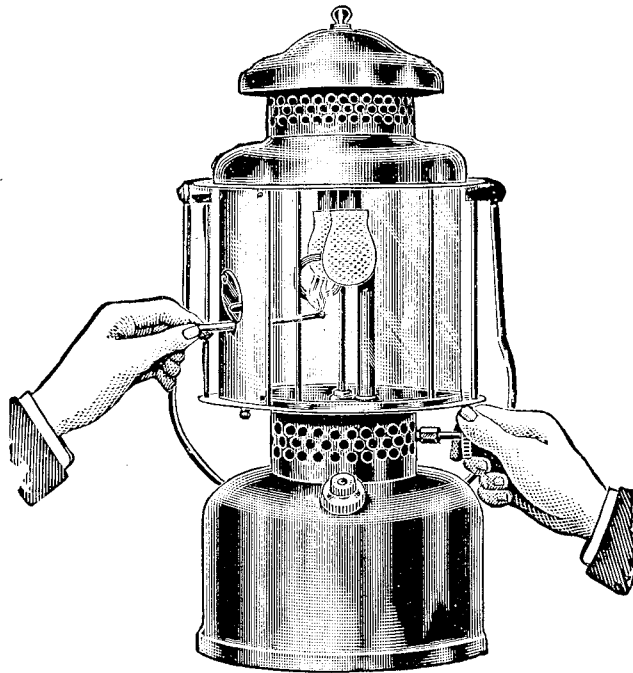

THE QUICK-LITE GAS LANTERN

The Quick-Lite Gas Lantern is the greatest development in a portable light for outdoor use in the history of artificial lighting. The value and usefulness of a lantern is measured by the service it gives—the light it produces. The Quick-Lite is a regular day-light maker. It holds 3 pints, burning 15 hours, and gives a brilliant light of 300 candle power, 20 times as much light as a common lantern and has a reflector which throws it wherever wanted.

NO ALCOHOL OR TORCH NEEDED

The Quick-Lite lights with a common match, hence its name. There is no hunting around for a torch, no bother with a bottle, no expense for alcohol.

STORM AND RAIN PROOF

It can't blow out or jar out. The wildest gale won't affect it. It burns perfectly in any wind, at any temperature, and will keep right on shining where it would be impossible to keep an oil lantern lighted. It gives the same brilliant light in hundreds of places where an oil lantern is useless.

IT IS SAFE

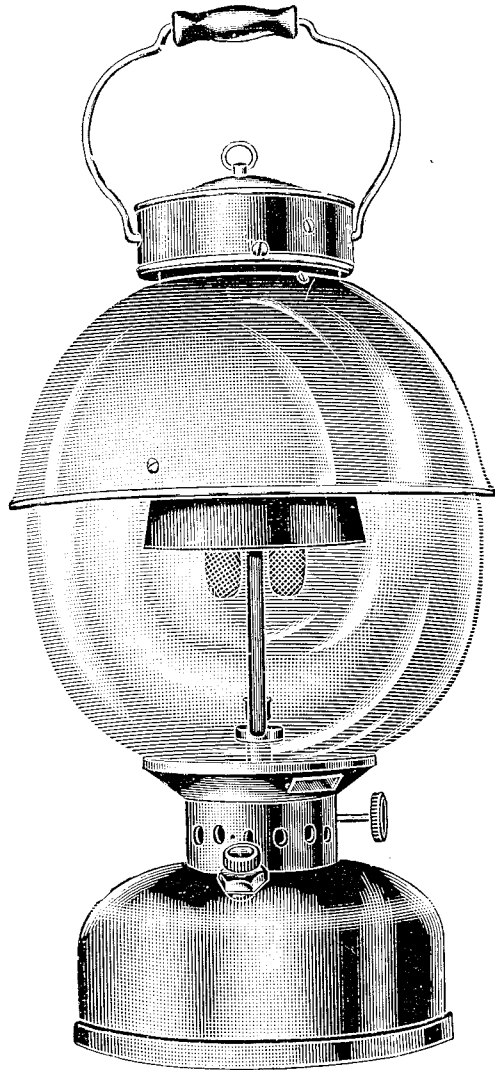
If tipped over it can't spill and can't explode. It can't be filled while burning. There is nothing to break or get out of order. This is demonstrated by rolling it around, tipping it over and showing the skeptical that it is safe in any position.

IT IS DURABLE

Quick-Lite Lanterns are made of heavily nickeled brass. They positively will not rust. Lanterns of steel or tin rust out as much as they wear out. The globe is of mica. The Quick-Lite has a double burner, using two small and very durable rag mantles. If one should jar off, the other still gives a good light. One mantle lanterns do not have this advantage.

THE COLEMAN ARC LANTERN

The Coleman Arc Lantern was the first successful gasoline lantern made and the only one like it on the market. It is larger than the usual type of lantern and having a small globe support casts but very little under shadow.

Like other Coleman Lamps the Arc Lantern makes its own gas from gasoline and is absolutely safe in any position. You can drop and roll it around with perfect safety.

It holds two quarts of fuel and will burn from twenty-five to thirty hours on one filling. Fill it once a week—clean it once a year. It gives 300 candle power and is storm-proof and bug-proof. Won't go out, even if tipped over—wind CAN'T blow it out. Most easily operated lantern made—no wicks, no chimneys, no smoke, no soot, no flicker, no danger—can't spill, can't explode, cheaper than oil. Lights with an alcohol torch.

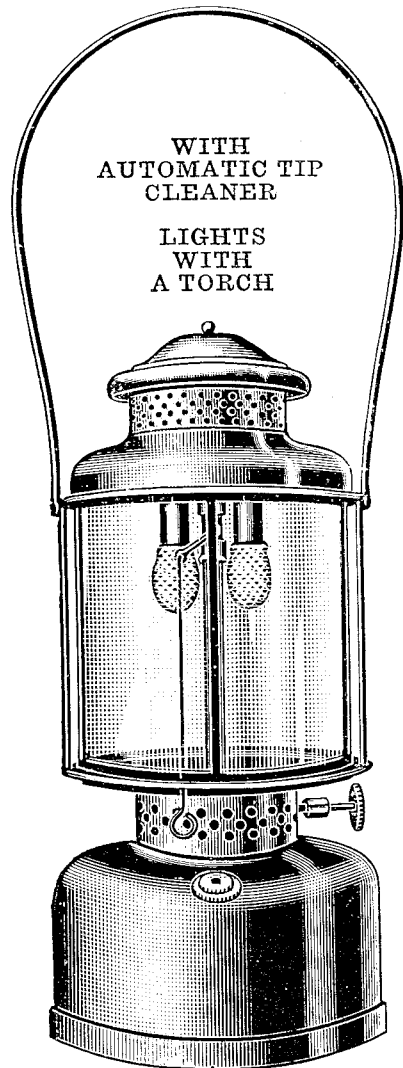
It is a great lantern for tent lighting and to hang in front of country stores and churches, it cannot be beaten. It is used in small towns and villages for street lighting and when placed on a post 6 to 8 feet from the ground will light up a yard for 300 or 400 feet in every direction. 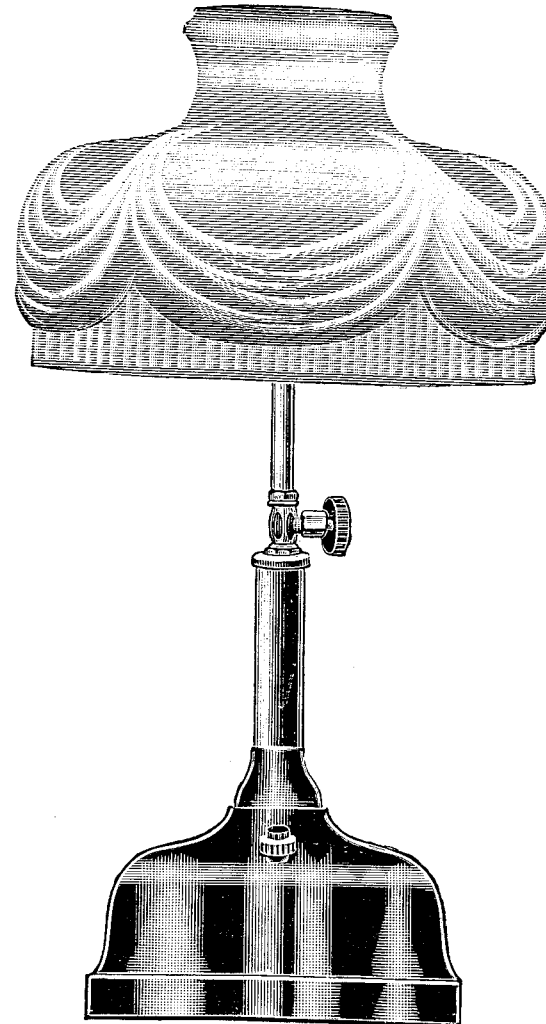
