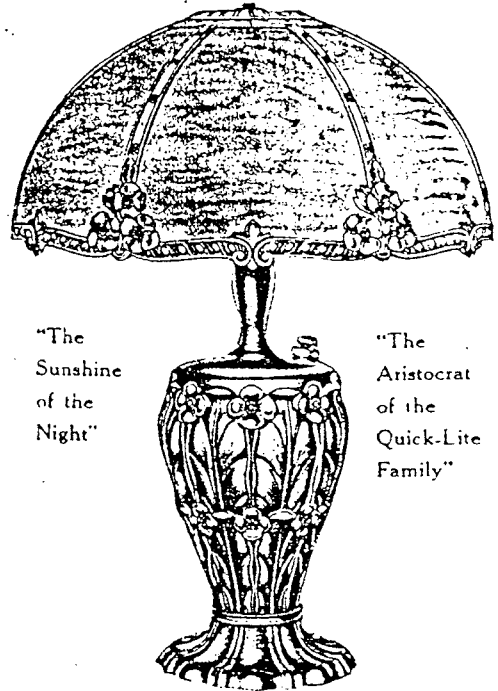

DESCRIPTION: The Coleman DeLuxe Quick-Lite Lamp was called "The Aristocrat of the Quick-Lite Family."

From a design standpoint, it was an abrupt departure from the classic styling of the popular CQ models. Functionally, it was unchanged. The lamp produced an abundance of light (300 candlepower). Diameter of the amber glass shade was 16 inches. Diameter at the base of the gold bronze base was 6 3/4 inches. The DeLuxe was 23 inches high and weighed 13 1/2 pounds with pump, wrench, cleaning pick and extra mantles. Selling price was about \$25 at retail.

While the DeLuxe was, in its time, a high style lamp, an attractive gift item and nationally advertised, sales were disappointing and none were made after 1926.
