

Coleman 1 Gallon Jugs

(Aluminum Handles Only)

1959 – 1965

- 1959 The "Snowlite" model jugs were first produced and all had porcelain liners. There were 2 different models available:
- 1). Custom - had a steel base
 - 2). Deluxe - had a Royalite base
- Available colors were: green, charcoal and patio pink
- 1960 The same jugs as in 1959 except that the charcoal color was discontinued. The "Snowlite Marine" model jug was added. This was the first model to have the polyethylene liner and later became known as the "molded liner".
- 1961 "Custom" model: this was the last year these were made with the top and bottom of steel gauge and a porcelain liner. Available colors were: green and patio pink.
"Deluxe" model was available in 2 different models: molded liner or porcelain liner. Both had the Royalite bases.
Available colors were: green and patio pink.
"Aristocrat Marine" model had a Royalite base with a molded liner. Available color was black/chrome only.
- 1962 "Custom" model was discontinued.
"Deluxe" model had a Royalite base with a molded liner.
Available colors were: green, aqua and patio pink.
This was the last year for the patio pink color.
"Aristocrat" model: this was the last year for this model with the Royalite base and molded liner. Available colors were: red/chrome, black/chrome and white/chrome.
- 1963 "Aristocrat" model was discontinued.
"Deluxe" model was available in the following colors: green, aqua and red.
- 1964 "Deluxe" model was available in following colors: green, aqua, red and beige with butternut base.
- 1965 "Deluxe" model was available in following colors: green, aqua, red and beige with butternut base.
- 1966 All jugs went to the plastic handles.
