

NAME AND TYPE LANTERN, Gasoline,

MODEL NUMBER -- "Sunshine" and "Yale Arco" (Air-O-Lantern Series)

PRODUCTION -- 1916-1917

DESCRIPTION: During the period 1916 to 1917 the then Coleman Lamp Company produced a limited number of its Arc Lanterns and Air-O-Lanterns under the trade names "Sunshine" and Arco-Lite", the latter being a division of The Coleman Lamp by reason of acquisition in 1914. The Yale Company continued in business under the name until well into the 1920s.

The Sunshine Safety Lamp Company of Kansas City, Mo., was a distributor of some Coleman products before its acquisition by Coleman.

In 1918 and for several years thereafter, sales of "Sunshine" and "Arco" lamps and lanterns were Coleman Quick-Lites.
