Gentlemen: Attention Mr. L. Rosso, Mgr.

Your letter received and we appreciate your giving us an opportunity to be of service. Inasmuch as Instant-Lite lamps and lanterns incorporate a new and different principle requiring a different method of lighting and operating, close attention should be given the directions until the new method of lighting and operating is fully understood. In this connection, it is suggested that each purchaser of an Instant-Lite be required themselves to light the lamp in the store once or twice before taking it out.

The Instant-Lite principle requires more care in the selection of gasoline. Also the fount should always be refilled as soon as about two-thirds or three-fourths empty. In many instances where trouble is reported in the operation of Instant-Lite lamps or lanterns, we find it is simply because the fuel in the fount is too low.

Our engineers recently worked out a new type feed line for inside the fount and in case the fuel tip on the end of the feed line is clogged or partly clogged, we are sending you one of these new feed lines under separate cover. Paragraph 9 of the direction sheet enclosed tells how to remove and replace the new feed line.

While you have the feed line out of the fount, be sure to drain the fount and rinse it with clean gasoline. All gasoline contains more or less foreign matter which will not vaporize but which remains in the fount. Unless the fount is cleaned occasionally, it will result in the fuel tip on the end of the feed line becoming clogged or corroded.

Along with the feed line we are sending you a new Q-77 generator equipped with a slightly larger gas tip which increases the supply of gas in proportion to the supply of air and which we recommend you install on the lamp. The instruction sheet enclosed also gives directions for installing the generator. If at any time the gas tip on the generator is clogged, it can be cleaned in accordance with the directions and with the use of the small cleaning wire accompanying each lamp.

The installation of these new parts we are sending you will bring the lamp up to date in regard to the improvements and operation and if your customers will be particular to guard against trying to use the lamp with too little fuel in the fount, we are sure that their efforts will be rewarded and each one will be a strong booster for Coleman Instant-Lite lamps.

If for any reason the lamp is not satisfactory after making the change recommended, kindly return it less the shade and we'll see that it is reconditioned and returned promptly by parcel post. If the lamp is returned, please be sure to notify us by letter referring to the date of this letter.
